


## **Praying for our king**

In a few days' time, King Charles III will be crowned. Aged 73, he will be the oldest monarch to ascend the throne that this country has ever known. His reign will certainly be shorter than that of his mother, but the time he has had to prepare for taking on the role has been much longer.

Over the years, King Charles has come in for some criticism, but he has also made a positive difference to so many people through the Prince's Trust, the Prince's

Foundation and the Prince's Charitable Fund, which have raised more than £100 million a year for good causes, with a notable concentration on young people and the environment. Like his father Prince Philip Duke of Edinburgh, Charles spoke out about environmental concerns long before anyone else took them seriously.

Now that he is king, Charles has to forge a new role for himself and Camilla. He has said that he will have to be less involved with charitable work than before, but his patronages are to be redistributed among other members of the Royal Family.

At times of change, Christians have always found it helpful to pray and to remind themselves of the God in whom they trust. Charles has said that he recognises his responsibility for the Church of England: "the Church in which my own faith is so deeply rooted". The Bible encourages us to pray for our leaders.

So what prayers would be helpful for the King in his new role? However much he has prepared for it, it will always be a big responsibility. Praying that he will know God's presence around him might be a good place to begin. And all leaders need wisdom — no surprise then that that was the gift King Solomon asked God for at the start of his reign. King Charles may be rich and powerful, but like the Lord Jesus Christ he understands that the role of king is to serve one's people not to lord it over them. This takes humility and empathy, a listening heart.

Charles has committed himself to all the people of this nation: "whatever may be your background or beliefs, I shall endeavour to serve you with loyalty, respect and love, as I have throughout my life." Let us pray that he manages to do just that.

#### Month on the Farm

The last of the spring barley was sown into some good seed beds on Good Friday. Some of the fields have had a coating of bio solids, which is a solid waste that is processed by Wessex Water through their sewage works and is a good source of slow release fertilizer/plant food and trace elements. With the warmer soils and longer daylight the crops will soon be emerging. The winter crops are growing well, and along with the spring ones, have all been rolled to push the stones into the soil so as not to



damage the harvesting equipment and to firm the plant root system, so enabling a good rooting system to take up the nutrients, find the moisture in a dry time and help to make a strong plant which is less lightly to fall over closer to ripening and harvest. The oil seed rape is just coming into flower, the bright yellow one!



Over the last couple of weeks most of the cattle have been turned out of the yards onto the spring grass, with only the youngsters having a small amount of rolled barley to help the rumen deal with the nutritious spring grass.

At the end of March we had another whole herd TB test of all the cattle; unfortunately one had tested positive to bovine TB and so all movements were stopped until the reactor was moved off the farm. Subsequently when the animal was slaughtered there were no visible lesions of TB present, so we can now start buying calves and selling the larger stores, albeit under strict movement licensing.

The last few ewes seem reluctant to lamb having had a very busy three weeks with lots of lambs popping out, mostly unaided - some being born indoors and lots being born outside with varying challenges from the weather and wildlife!.

We swapped the cardboard eggs for Easter treats which the children took home in little baskets they had made. We learnt all about eggs and which different creatures hatch from them. Our story was "The Odd Egg" by Emily Gravett where poor duck finds an egg which he waits to hatch only to find a crocodile inside. Following this, the children chose and drew pictures of what they wanted to hatch from their egg. We cut big egg shapes from paper that we had previously marbled, cut in two and, using a split pin, hinged the piec-

es to reveal what was in their egg.

Humpty Dumpty had to be included – well he is an egg. The children drew Humpty's face on an oval shape then 'broke' it in half and used plasters to stick him back together again. Much fun although rather fiddly for some.

## Milborme St Andrew First School

Investigating the tracks that animals and people leave behind.

We drew around our shoes to leave footprint tracks on the playground using chalk, and asked a friend to follow the line of tracks. This was a trail that someone else could follow, recalling when we read, 'Rosie's Walk', where Rosie went on a journey following a trail.

We followed this up by visiting Moors Valley, where we could walk around a nature trail. A nature trail is a circular, signposted path with signs, symbols and photographs at intervals to draw the walker's attention to natural features. Along the walk Miss Wittman talked with the chil-

dren about physical or natural

features they observed (things that would be present even if humans were not) and human made items and encouraged them to describe what they saw. Whilst investigating the environment we recorded (through photographs) and talked about those features of the natural world we liked most.



Back at school, the children were asked to recall the order in which they completed the dragon school challenges along the trail, using appropriate vocabulary, and created their own simple nature trail with photographs, drawings and labels of the features to be visited in the correct order.




