



Transitions

As I write this letter, I and the rest of the country, if not the world, are coming to terms with the sudden death of our Queen Elizabeth. Although we knew she was not going to live forever, her sudden death certainly came as a shock, particularly as just two days earlier she had received our new Prime Minister at Balmoral. We had barely absorbed the news of our Queen's death when we were told that Prince Charles was now King - King Charles III. Of course

we knew this would happen but it seemed to be announced in the very next breath, with no space to process the sad news we had only just heard. I can hardly imagine how the new King must have been feeling. He was overheard saying to a well wisher that he had 'really dreaded this day'. I am not surprised.

And so like the Royal Family, as a nation we have entered a time of great transition. Our beloved Queen has died, we have a new King, and we also have a new prime minister. Momentous change in just a few short days; and uncertainty in the days and weeks ahead as we all adjust to new roles, to new leadership and new positions. Like his mother before him, King Charles now becomes the 'Supreme Governor of the Church of England' and he has already spoken of his 'deeply rooted Christian faith' and the values it inspires in him, and how his faith and these values will guide the way in which he fufffils his duties as King.

We are also facing another period of transition in the country as we say goodbye to September, and welcome in October. We are transitioning from a long hot summer marked by heatwaves and drought, into the beauty that is autumn. Harvests have been gathered in, harvest festivals and suppers are being held. But the impact of the drought, heatwave and continuing war in Ukraine have had a significant impact on crops across the country and the world. This in turn has led to food shortages and price increases, including significant price increases in the fuel we use to drive our cars and heat our homes. A great number of people are now struggling to make ends meet, making difficult choices between buying food or fuel.

On the same day that our Queen died, our new Prime Minister announced plans to freeze energy bills, in an attempt to bring in measures to support those in need. Because of our time of national mourning, we have not yet heard how else the government plans to support the thousands of people who are struggling; they are still waiting anxiously to hear. We have seen in the past few days how the people of the United Kingdom have come together in their grief. Differences have been laid aside as strangers have supported one another. We have demonstrated that as a people we can come together in times of great need. Christians have been called by God to be a generous people, to love one another, to feed the hungry, clothe the naked and set the



Month on the Farm

The harvest has now all been brought in, even the linseed which is usually harvested after everything else well into September, was cut in August. Surprisingly in spite of the dry conditions the yields of grain and straw were good. The grains did not need drying although the intense heat did mean we have had to cool the grain once it's in the store as the warm grain is a good place for all the grain bugs to breed, and a bug in a lorry load of corn causes rejection of the load and lots of hassle!



The drill has been busy placing the very small seeds of turnips into the ground and the warm rains which eventually came, have made the seed germinate and relieve the worry of lack of fodder

for the livestock over the winter months. The rains have also made the grass grow again and turned the fields of brown, dusty, dry grass into lovely green pastures and we have been able to stop feeding some of the groups the hay and silage that they so desperately needed to keep them fed over what seemed like a long hot summer!!



We have drilled some oil seed rape again this year, something we have not done for a couple of years due to the rape beetle decimating the growing crop last time we attempted it. With some good results on some contracted land we decided to give it a go again as it makes a very good break crop between the barley and wheat crops and of course where possible, we as farmers have been encouraged to grow it as the problems in the Ukraine have resulted in a European shortage when more cooks are using more of it.



In September we enjoyed a presentation given by local plantsman Steve Jeffries, who taught us all about selecting and growing house plants.


